- Check that the throttle lever is in the IDLE
- Pull out the starter handle slowly until the starter has engaged with the engine, then pull it back quickly and strongly. It ld not be pulled too far, or it may
- The cord should be guided back into place so that it recoils correctly.
- If the engine is now running set the choke control to half position. It can be opened up gently as the engine warms
- 10. If the engine did not start, check there is sufficient petrol and oil, and that all controls are in the correct positions. Pull the starter cord again.

- The rest of the instructions must be followed from instruction 5 onwards, given in the section 'starting from cold'.

USING THE VIBRATING ROLLER

- Wear the protective equipment including safety boots and gloves. Hands, feet and clothing must always be kept away from moving parts of the roller.
- The handlebars of the vibrating roller should be held firmly with two hands

- before pulling the control lever in the steering arm may move unexpectedly as the drive is taken up.
- The roller can be turned and manoeuvred easily using the engine to drive it forwards and backwards. Take care not to move the roller with the drum or engine stopped.
- Before driving the roller in reverse check that there are no obstructions ine release the control leave straight away.
- Make sure that any support lack has been retracted before starting work
- If the roller has a water sprinkler system, it should be used to prevent the compacted surface sticking to the drum.
- Vibration may affect the hands and it is important to watch out for signs of this. If fingers tingle or start to feel numb, a short break must be taken from using the roller. Fingers should be exercised to encourage blood circulation.
- To help prevent vibration affecting the hands, operate the roller for shorter periods. Keeping hands warm vearing gloves may help to do this
- The vibrating action should not be operated on very hard surfaces such as concrete or frozen ground.
- If an obstruction becomes jammed in the drum scraper, or something gets tangled in the drive mechanism, the engine must be stopped before clearing it.
- The engine must be stopped if leaving the machine unattended
 - If the equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company

Vibrating Roller

0110 Vibrating roller - 4 stroke petrol

- Petrol is highly flammable. Take care not to cause a fire or explosion.
- This vibrating roller is designed to compact crushed hardcore backfill, asphalt and other road surfacing materials on level surfaces or gentle slopes
- The action of this vibrating roller can cause injury or damage if the machine is not used in a careful and controlled way
- If the operator has not used a vibrating roller before, they should familiarise themselves with the machine on some straightforward work before starting on the main task
- The work should be thought out and planned to ensure it will be carried out safely.
- A minimum of the following personal protective equipment must be worn:
 - Ear muffs or plugs giving protection for levels up to 96 dB(A);
 - Safety boots to EN345 or BS1870/4972:
- This machine must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- This vibrating roller is designed for operation by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.
