

Roughcast Applicator

The rules and procedures in force where people are at work may require the person responsible for this equipment to carry out a specific risk assessment.

It is important to read all of this leaflet **BEFORE** using the Roughcast Applicator

- 1. Cement mixes are harmful to eyes, lungs and skin. Follow any instructions given by the manufacturers of these cement products.
- 2. This roughcast applicator is designed for the application of a Tyrolean type cement finish to external and internal walls. It will also apply plaster and proprietary paint mixes as a decorative finish.



- The action of this equipment can cause injury or damage if the equipment is not used in a careful and controlled way
- If you have not used a roughcast applicator before, familiarise yourself with how the equipment works before you start on the main task.
- Plan your work and think ahead to make sure you will always be working safely.
- You must have at least the following items of personal protective equipment: goggles: EN166 or BS2092; dust mask - a minimum of EN149 ffp2(s) protection; overalls with long sleeves and full trousers; gloves.
- This equipment must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- This roughcast applicator is designed for operation by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it
