# **Using the Hedge Trimmer**

- Wear your protective equipment including ear defenders, goggles and face mask.
- Make sure there is no-one in your area of work.
- Always hold the hedge trimmer firmly with both hands.
- Make sure the cutting blade is running at full speed before starting to cut into the hedge.
- Do not try to cut thick twigs. This hedge trimmer is for trimming foliage.
- Do not try to cut off all growth in one pass, remove it one layer at a time. Make sure that you can control the amount you are removing before you take off the final laver.
- Beware of debris that may be thrown out by the trimming blade.
- If the hedge trimmer starts to labour and slow down do not force it so hard. Do not overload the engine.
- Stop the hedge trimmer if someone approaches you.
- 10. Stop the engine and make sure the trimming blade has stopped before making
- 11. Stop the engine before leaving the machine unattended.
- 12. If your equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
- 13. You may want to read this leaflet again. Please keep it until you finish work.

# **Petrol Hedge Trimmer**

The rules and procedures in force where people are at work may require the person responsible for this equipment to carry out a specific risk assessment.

1607 Hedge trimmer - 2 stroke petrol

- Petrol mixture is highly flammable. Take care not to cause a fire or explosion.
- This hedge trimmer is designed for cutting back and trimming hedges, shrubs and smaller plants
- The sharp trimming blade reciprocates very fast and can cause injury or damage if the machine is not used in a careful and controlled way.
- 4. If you have not used a hedge trimmer before, familiarise yourself with how the machine works before you start the main task.
- Plan your work and think ahead to make sure you will always be working safely.
- You must have at least the following items of personal protective equipment: Goggles – impact resistant EN 166-B or BS2092 grade 1; Ear muffs or plugs giving protection for levels up to 104db (A); Face mask, EN149 ffp2s; Gloves.
